Enter deer-resistant plants. Here are some favorite deer-resistant shrubs and ideas on how to use them for your next landscape transformation!







SUPERSTAR™ SPIREA

ZONES 3-8

- Scarlet red new growth matures to deep green and eventually bronze in fall.
- Pink blooms appear in June and will rebloom in August if spent blooms are deadheaded.
- Ideal compact shrub to plant at the front of a garden bed or in a deco pot.





FLIP SIDE® CHASTETREE ZONES 7-9

- 8-inch, fragrant, deep purple flowers are magnets for pollinators.
- Unique greyish olive-green leaves are dusky purple on the lower surface.
- Great for a focal point or in mixed borders.





SUMMER CASCADE™ WISTERIA ZONES 4-8

- Clusters of purple-dark lavender flowers bloom in June.
- Unique seeds pods are produced in late summer.
- A gorgeous flowering vine for pergolas and other garden structures.





CINNAMON GIRL® DISTYLIUM ZONES 7-9

- Plum-purple new growth turns blue-green as it matures.
- Compact, disease-resistant shrub that adds a refined look to the garden.
- Perfect evergreen for mass plantings and garden borders.
