#### AUTUMN REVOLUTION<sup>™</sup> BITTERSWEET **ZONES 2-8**

- Native vine to North America that produces bright orange berries in late summer and fall.
- A self fertile bittersweet, requiring only one plant to produce fruit.
- · Perfect to add interest to built structures like fences and to cut and use in DIY crafts.







#### CANDY<sup>™</sup> CORALBERRY ZONES 4-9

- Covered in candy-pink berries in fall after the pink summer blooms.
- · Arching stems support berries throughout the winter and can be used in cut flower arrangements.
- · Compact shape is useful for foundation and mass plantings.

#### AUTUMN INFERNO<sup>™</sup> COTONEASTER **ZONES 5-7**

- Clean green leaves turn a striking red in autumn.
- Bright red berries form along the stems and add to late season interest.
- Can be pruned to create a formal hedge or left to grow naturally to celebrate the arched shape.
